Vacant Position: Ortho-Prosthetist

A. About the ICRC

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) is an impartial, neutral, and independent humanitarian organization whose exclusively humanitarian mission is to protect the lives and dignity of victims of armed conflict and other situations of violence and to provide them with assistance.

In Iran, the ICRC works closely with national authorities and partners, including the Iranian Red Crescent Society (IRCS), to strengthen humanitarian response and support vulnerable populations through a range of protection and assistance activities.

B. Position Purpose

A multi-skilled and flexible Ortho-Prosthetist will contribute to implementation of the Physical Rehabilitation activities, particularly in relation to improved quality and capacity of the professionals delivering prosthetic, orthotic (P&O) and wheelchair services in the supported structures of partner organizations, in Tehran, southern, western and eastern Iran.

As a member of the Physical Rehabilitation Multidisciplinary team, and under the direct supervision of Health Programme Manager, s/he contributes to the implementation of internal and international P&O standards, overall rehabilitation service provision standards and monitoring the quality of the services provided (from service user registration to discharge).

C. Key Responsibilities

The successful candidate:

- Supports the improvement of services through the implementation of the multi/interdisciplinary team approach within the physical rehabilitation services
- Supports the partner organizations to supervise the technical staff in all ICRC supported centers regarding all clinical and technical issues.
- Supports the partner organizations in all P&O technical activities necessary for orthotic and prosthetic fabrication, appliance rehabilitation, follows up any ICRC training and ensures knowledge translation.
- Participates in local clinical meetings to improve P&O services and promote physical rehabilitation activities along the full continuum of care.
- Promotes best practice in coordination with the center team and is actively involved in the delivery of services to complicated/complex cases.

- University degrees in prosthetist and orthotist field.
- Minimum **2 years of relevant clinical experience**.
- Excellent organizational and coordination skills.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Good command of spoken and written English.
- Native proficiency in Persian (Farsi).
- Good knowledge of Microsoft Office applications (Excel, Word, Outlook and PowerPoint).
- Ability to work independently and manage multiple priorities.
- High level of integrity, confidentiality and attention to detail.
- Ability to work effectively in a multicultural and humanitarian environment
